

## DOMINION strengthens its environmental business through the acquisition of a plastics recovery company

- The transaction strengthens DOMINION's position as a leading provider of integrated industrial waste recovery and valorisation solutions, while expanding its presence in a strategic segment of the circular economy.
- The company is expanding its circular economy capabilities through the acquisition of Reyuplas, a company specialising in the recovery and recycling of industrial plastics.
- This acquisition is the latest of three environmental-sector transactions completed by DOMINION over the past year, reinforcing the growth roadmap of its Global Dominion Environment (GDE) business.

**Bilbao, July 9, 2026** – DOMINION, the global projects and services company helping drive the transformation of key industries towards more sustainable, efficient and connected business models, has strengthened its environmental business with the acquisition of an 80% stake in Reyuplas, a **company specialising in the sorting, recovery and recycling of industrial plastics**.

The acquisition marks **another step forward in the growth strategy** of Global Dominion Environment (GDE), expanding its circular economy capabilities by adding expertise in the recovery and recycling of a waste stream that already passes through its transfer facilities. The transaction further diversifies DOMINION's **value proposition for industrial customers**.

**Founded in 1999** and headquartered in Cuenca, Spain, Reyuplas specialises in plastics recovery, **transforming recovered plastic waste into recycled raw materials**, particularly high- and low-density polyethylene (HDPE and LDPE) for a wide range of industrial applications.

"The addition of Reyuplas strengthens our circular economy capabilities and expands our presence in a high-growth segment such as the **recovery and recycling of industrial plastics**. This transaction represents another important milestone in the execution of GDE's growth strategy and supports our ambition to **build an increasingly robust environmental platform**," said DOMINION.

This acquisition **brings the number of environmental-sector transactions completed by DOMINION since 2025 to four**. During this period, the company has expanded its environmental platform through the acquisition of the **German company ZCR GmbH, a water treatment plant in Cartagena**, the **Ecogestión de Residuos** transfer facility, and now **Reyuplas**.
